## Game Card Check List:

Division Reps are to confirm the following information is filled out accurately:

| Field | Description | Example |
| :--- | :--- | :--- |
| Region | Will always be "46" | 46 |
| Division | Must be prefaced by B or G | G6U, B10U, G14U, etc. |
| Team \# | Team number from coach packet | $2,5,16,20$, etc. |
| Team Name | Name of team (approved by Div Rep) | Galaxy |
| Team Colors | Primary jersey color | Royal Blue |
| Coach | Head coach first and last name | Bruce Jones |
| Assistant Coach | Assistant coach first and last name | Dave Smith |
| Player \# | Jersey number for each player listed in <br> NUMBER order (filled in numbers starting <br> with \#2 without player names - those are <br> filled in after uniform distribution) | $2,3,4,5,6$, etc. |

## Important Notes:

1. Coaches have been instructed to complete 12 game cards and bring them to the Division Reps along with other paperwork when they pick up uniforms.
a. Division Reps will verify that all 12 game cards are complete and accurate prior to releasing uniforms. Division Reps will stamp each game card and return to the coach.
2. Make sure that the division field is prefaced with a " $G$ " or a " $B$ " (G6U, B10U, G14U, etc.). If the coach forgets, it can be hand written in at check-in time rather than making them redo the cards.
3. Coaches will not have uniforms when they fill out the game cards so they just need to write in the jersey numbers in ascending order (based on the standard counts by division):
a. B/G 6U:

6 players ( $2,3,4,5,6,7$ )
b. B/G 7U:

6 players ( $2,3,4,5,6,7$ )
c. $\mathrm{B} / \mathrm{G} 8 \mathrm{U}$ :

6 players ( $2,3,4,5,6,7$ )
d. B/G 10U:

9 players ( $2,3,4,5,6,7,8,9,10$ )
e. B/G 12U:

11 players ( $2,3,4,5,6,7,8,9,10,11,12$ )
f. B/G 14U: $\quad 13$ or 14 players ( $2,3,4,5,6,7,8,9,10,11,12,13,14,15$ )
g. B/G 16U: $\quad 114$ or 15 players ( $2,3,4,5,6,7,8,9,10,11,12,13,14,15,16$ )
